2021-2022 APPROPRIATIONS ACT (2021)

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The Legislature of Tsawwassen First Nation enacts as follows:

Citation

1 This Act may be cited as the Appropriations Act 2021

Definitions

2 In this Act:

"fiscal year" means April 1 of 2021 to March 31 of 2022.

Appropriations for 2021-2022

3 (1) The director of finance is authorized to pay the amounts outlined in schedules 1 through 13 of this Act from the Tsawwassen First Nation general revenue fund for the purposes outlined in each schedule.

Revenues for 2021-2022

The Tsawwassen First Nation Government's estimated revenues and anticipated revenue sources for the fiscal year are set out in Appendices 1 and 2 of this Act.
