2017-2018 APPROPRIATIONS ACT (2017)

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| Citation |
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The Legislature of Tsawwassen First Nation enacts as follows:

Citation

1 This Act may be cited as the *Appropriations Act 2017*

Definitions

2 In this Act:

"fiscal year" means April 1 of 2017 to March 31 of 2018.

Appropriations for 2017-2018

- 3 (1) The director of finance is authorized to pay the amounts outlined in schedules 1 through 12 of this Act from the Tsawwassen First Nation general revenue fund for the purposes outlined in each schedule.
 - (2) The director of finance is authorized to transfer the amount outlined in schedule 13 to the TFN Economic Development Corporation for its operating expenditures. The expenditures in schedule 13 are approved, subject to an independent assessment of the TFN Economic Development Corporation mandate and operations to be commissioned by Executive Council. Upon completion of the assessment, Executive Council will make any revisions to the budgeted expenditures contained in this schedule that it deems necessary, at which time the resulting revisions, as approved by Executive Council, will have the same force and affect as if provided by this Legislature.
 - (3) The Tsawwassen First Nation Government will permit the numbered company 600911 BC Ltd., doing business as Tsatsu Gas, to retain revenue from the provision of goods and services for the purpose of funding its operating expenditures, which are set out in Schedule 14.
 - (4) The Tsawwassen First Nation Government will permit the TFN Commercial Lands Corporation to retain revenue for necessary expenditures, which are set out in Schedules 15.
 - (5) The Tsawwassen First Nation Government will permit the TFN Industrial Lands Corporation to retain revenue for necessary expenditures, which are set out in Schedules 16.

Revenues for 2017-2018

4 The Tsawwassen First Nation Government's estimated revenues and anticipated revenue sources for the fiscal year are set out in Appendices 1 and 2 of this Act.
