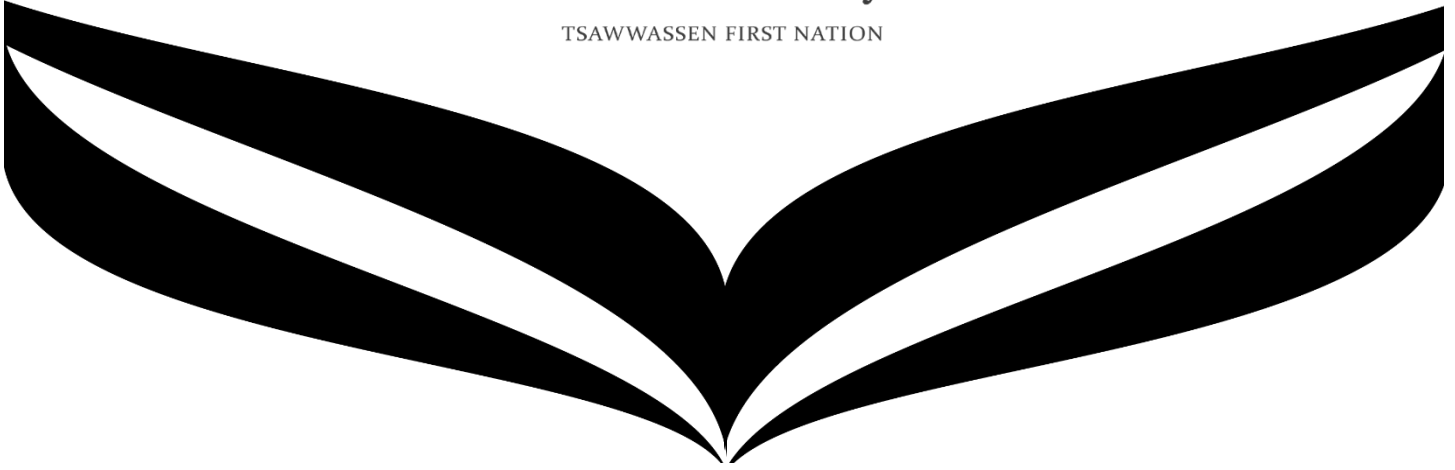

## SECOND VACCINE CLINIC ON JUNE 6

The Tsawwassen Government is excited to announce that TFN's second COVID-19 vaccine clinic will be on Sunday, June 6. Staff will reach out to everyone who received their first dose at TFN's first vaccine clinic on March 3 to schedule you for your second dose. If you have not received your first dose, and you would like to be vaccinated now, please reach out to Health and Social Services (604-948-5231) and we will work with you to schedule your first dose.

**12-17 year-olds are now eligible for the Pfizer vaccine, and we are excited to be able to schedule you for your first dose at the June 6 vaccine clinic.** To be eligible, you must have turned 12 by June 6, be a Tsawwassen Member or live with a Tsawwassen Member in the Lower Mainland or in the Fraser Health Region. Anyone 13 years and older can provide your own informed consent. This means that you decide for yourself if you want the vaccine or not. 12 year-olds need parental consent. Staff will reach out to all 12-17 year-old Members living in the Lower Mainland and Fraser Health Region to ask if you would like to be vaccinated. If you are a non-Member aged 12-17 that is living with one or more Members, please reach out to Chris Kyllèsø ([ckylleso@tsawwassenfirstnation.com](mailto:ckylleso@tsawwassenfirstnation.com) or 604-788-9683) and we will schedule an appointment for you.

Please be aware that staff will not be able to accommodate for anyone's schedule for your second dose vaccine appointment. You can take up to 3 hours paid leave to be vaccinated against COVID-19. Employees are entitled to this leave no matter how long they have been employed (Government of BC). We are working on scheduling a Vaccine Education Workshop with the First Nations Health Authority (FNHA). Everyone is welcome to attend and ask questions about the vaccine.
