INFRASTRUCTURE

HOUSING



- Continue offering turnkey ownership options for Members like the duplexes
- Improvements to the rental housing on Raven Lane are great

MEMBERS GATHERING



- Hosting off Lands gives all Members a break from being home
- More social activities should be included during the day
- Accommodations should be nearby, especially for Elders

NATURAL RESOURCES



- Members appreciate taking the Possession and Acquisition License (PAL) course on Lands
- Fisherpeople need support with the cost of insurance and moorage
- Storage is needed for boats and trailers parked around Lands

EDUCATION & YOUTH



- More programs are needed for young children under 5
- Inform youth of postsecondary options outside of university
- Students need more support to purchase technology for schooling
