GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Full application package** Submit completed Application Form with accompanied drawings and documents to planningpermits@tsawwassenfirstnation.com or in-person to the TFN Lands Department, at least 90 calendar days before the first day of any Event. Submissions must be in digital form, hard copy drawings and documents may be requested by TFN after Preliminary Review.
- Fees and Damage Deposits** Public Event Permit fee: \$250/day of Event plus applicable taxes. Damage Deposit: up to \$5000. A Fee Slip for Fees and Damage Deposits will be prepared and must be paid in advance of permit issuance.
