

Falcon Way Improvements



Dear Residents:

Following TFN's notice update dated April 28, 2026, Amrize Canada has been engaged to undertake the works for the Falcon Way Improvements project.

Project Schedule

The official start date for the project is **June 23, 2026**.

The first week of construction, beginning June 23, will involve "soft mobilization" activities such as site setup and equipment staging. There will be no road closures during this period.

The work will be executed in two distinct phases:

- **Phase 1:** Intersection of Tsawwassen Drive and Falcon Way to Falcon Way and Cormorant Drive (**Early Summer 2026 – Late Fall 2026**).
- **Phase 2:** Intersection of Falcon Way and Cormorant Drive to the northeast end of Falcon Way (**Early Spring 2027 – Late Fall 2027**).

Resident Impacts and Notifications

We are committed to minimizing disruptions. Please note the following impact details:

- **Traffic Control:** Traffic will be maintained as single-lane alternating, with no full road closures.
- **Driveway Access:** Intermittent interruptions during working hours; access will be restored after hours.
- **Parking:** On-street parking will be restricted within the active work zone.
- **Property Notifications:** Advance notice will be provided prior to any work in front of individual properties.
- **Waste Management:** Garbage and recycling collection will NOT be affected.
